- 1. Express Your Interest** in serving to the Volunteer Coordinator, DeeAnn Fisher. You may contact her by phone/ text (248) 974-5287 or email deeannfisher@gmail.com.
- 2. Receive Volunteer Application Package....**read over the information in the package and complete it when you're ready to move forward in serving!
- 3. Observe Programs...We call this a "first serve."** Before you fill out and turn in the application, you are encouraged to observe a student ministry weekly program or event. This is a great opportunity to get a better feel for the ministry. You will have a chance to meet students, other volunteers and write down any questions you may have.
- 4. Pray** about your involvement with the student ministry.
- 5. Complete application package and return to Volunteer Coordinator...**This application was developed to obtain appropriate information for our screening process. This process not only protects us and our students, but it protects YOU. In the unfortunate case that false accusations are made concerning a volunteer's integrity, we have this process to show that you are credible and have a clean history. We require a completed application and a background check.
- 6. Interview with Minister to Students...**This is an opportunity for you to share your thoughts, describe your spiritual journey, and communicate your gifts and desires for working with student ministries but most of all it is a chance for Dan to hear your heart. He can really help you find your best fit for serving.
- 7. Sign Leadership Commitment and Begin Ministry!...**This commitment will be signed and completed at your interview.
- 8. Attend Volunteer Meetings...**Attend quarterly meetings that will focus on upcoming event planning, learning how to better serve in the student ministry. These meetings insure that we are all headed in the same direction in ministry. There will also be occasional training events to give you to the tools you need to grow as a volunteer.
